



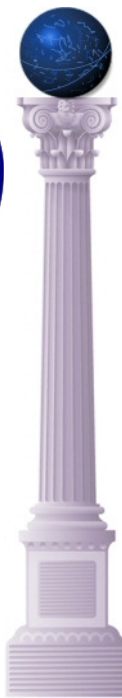

Continue to grow awareness in the community by providing food and beverages during Palm Harbor functions

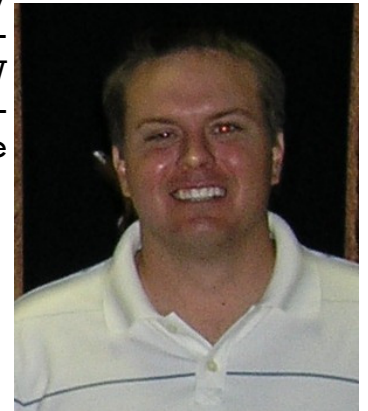
At minimum we will have 2 work parties
